LifeGroup Study Guide:

Read John 6:22-27. How would you describe Jesus' response to the crowd in these verses? Why does He respond this way? When in your life has God responded differently than you expected or desired?

Read John 6:66. Why did the crowd withdraw from Jesus? Have there been any times in your life when you were tempted to walk away from Jesus because your circumstances weren't going how you wanted?

Read Matthew 13:44-46 and John 6:67-68. Why did the disciples respond so differently from the crowd?

What are you treasuring more than Jesus right now? What are you trying to use Jesus to get? (i.e. where do you want the gifts of God more than God Himself)?

Would you say Jesus is your greatest treasure? Why or why not?

- Would you give up everything to have Him?
- Would you give up control over your life direction to have Him?
- Are you willing to give up your dreams to have him?
- Would you give up your preferred sex life to have him?
- Would heaven be heaven if you got everything else you wanted but Jesus wasn't there?

How are you actively feasting on the bread of life?

How as a LifeGroup can we encourage each other to repent from using Jesus to get other gifts and remember that Jesus is the best that life has to offer?
