One Big Thing:

Review:

This week in Kidtown we reviewed some of the big ideas from our HOME series. We discussed the idea that home isn't just a house that people live in. A: Jesus is with us to comfort and guide us. He is helping us invite others to know Him by making new friends and sharing His love with them. He wants us to invite others into God's big family so that they can also be with us in our forever home.
