Memory Verse:

One Big Thing:

A wise person humbly worships and obeys God.

Review:

This week, we dove deeper together into what it looks like to be a wise person. We said that a wise person humbly worships and obeys God! We talked about the Wise Builder versus the Foolish Builder from Matthew 7:24-27, that Wise Builders build their lives on God’s words in the Bible. That way, when bad or sad things happen to them or when they are tempted to do bad things, they are able to stand strong and continue to live the good life the way that God intended. However, we know that we are not able to do this on our own. We need Jesus to help us be wise.

Good Questions to Ask:

1. **Q:** What do wise people do?

A: Wise people worship and obey God. They build their lives on what God says, especially what He says in the Bible.

2. **Q:** What did the wise builder do in Matthew 7:24-27?

A: He built his life on the rock-- on God's words, worshiping and obeying God.

3. **Q:** Are we able to worship and obey God on our own?

A: No, we need Jesus to help us to want him.
