Series Memory Verse:

One Big Thing:

God chooses imperfect people to be a part of His story.

Review:

This week, we continued to talk about God's great, big, huge, and best of all TRUE story. We focused on how God's people became slaves in Egypt, but God rescued them. God is continuing to show us that He keeps His promises to His people. Ultimately, God does this by sending Jesus. However, along the way, God uses imperfect people, like Moses and like us, to be a part of His story. God hears His people's cries for help and is faithful and powerful to rescue them.





Good Questions to Ask:

1. **Q:** As review, what did we learn that God promised to Abraham?

A: God promised to give to Abraham a family as big as the number of stars in the sky and sand on the seashore. He also promised to use Abraham's family to bring good to the whole entire world.

2. **Q:** Abraham's family had grown much bigger at this point in God's story, but they were in trouble. Who did God send to rescue them?

A: God sent Moses--an imperfect person, just like us--to rescue His people from slavery to the Egyptians.

3. **Q:** In Redemption, who has God sent to rescue us from sin?

A: God sent Jesus to rescue us from our sin by living a perfect life, dying on the cross for our sins, and rising again from the dead.

Pray together as a family:

"Father, thank You for making us a part of Your big, huge story through Jesus. Thank You for using imperfect people, like Moses and like us, to be a part of Your story. Help us to remember that just like God's people during the time of Moses, we too are in need of help because of our sin and every day need Jesus to rescue us!"
